Tickets:

- You need to buy your ticket in advance. Tickets cannot be bought on the train.
- We recommend you to buy 24-hour cards for the public transport system. This card covers the transport by train to and from Stockholm as well as subways, buses, trams and some of the ferries in Stockholm.

Please remember! You will always get the best exchange rate when using a card.

(Reduced price: Children age 12-19, students and adults over 65 years. Children under the age of 12 travel for free when accompanied by an adult ticket holder).

The station in Nynäshamn:

- A walk to the train station takes 15-20 minutes. Follow the blue line.
- A shuttle bus runs between the cruise ship pier and the station every 15 minutes in the morning and afternoon. This bus is **not** included in the 24-hour card.
- Return tickets for the shuttle bus:
- Price/adult: SEK 40 / € 4.5 / USD\$ 5.5
Price/children 6-19 years: SEK 20 / € 2.5 / US\$ 3

Ticket retailers:

- The office by the cruise ship pier.
Accepts: Visa, MasterCard, SEK, Euro, USD
- The yellow kiosk by the station.
- Vending Machine on the platform (only credit cards with pin-code)

The stations in Stockholm:

- In Stockholm City, the trains run underground. Look for the “Commuter train” signs.
- The train departs from Stockholm Södra (Stockholm South station) approximately 3 minutes after departing from Stockholm City.

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
